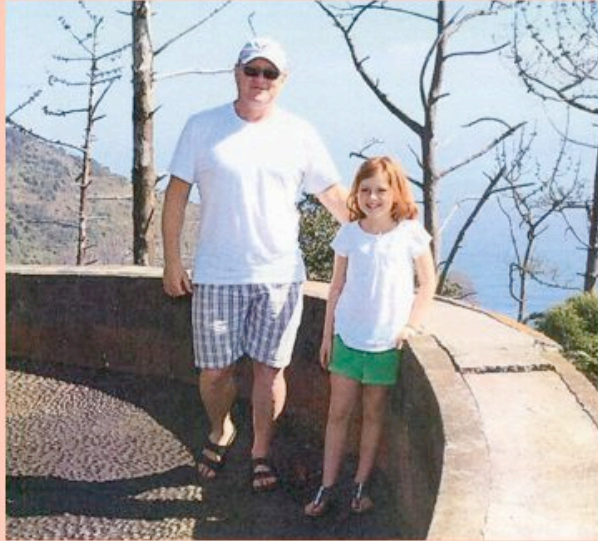


SHAW, Gary P. -
